Intended Use:

Tourniquets are non-inflatable (non-pneumatic) devices intended to be used as an effective way to achieve controlled vessel constriction. Latex-free tourniquet with Hook & Loop contact closure can be applied easily and instantly for perfect venous or arterial constriction.

Caution: Do not attempt to use this equipment without proper training.

Instructions:

1. When applying tourniquet, be sure label is face down on skin.
2. Hold label firmly with one hand and at the same time, stretch the tourniquet to encircle the limb.
3. Adjust to tension desired for clinical or first aid use, lock into place with Hook & Loop contact closure.

Care and Maintenance

Clean tourniquet with an alcohol wipe after each use.



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
